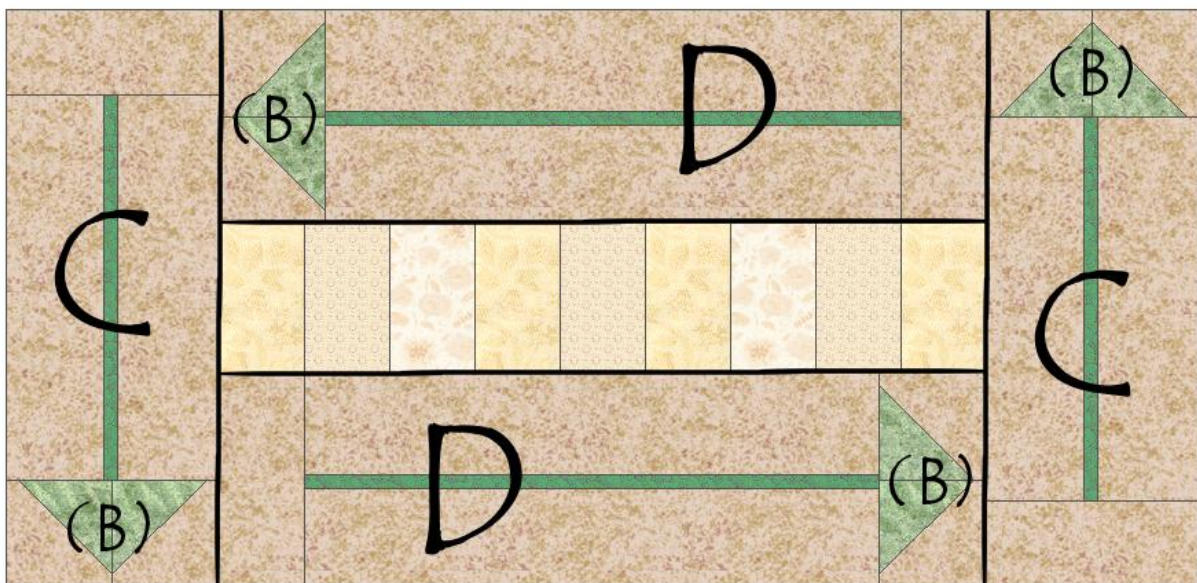
## Patchwork-piece

1. Find 9 of the 2,5" x 4" pieces.
2. Sew the pieces together to get a patchwork piece at 4" x 18,5".



## Sewing it together

Look at the picture and place the different parts as shown:



1. Sew the long parts together first: **block D + patchwork-piece + block D**
2. Sew **block C** at each side.

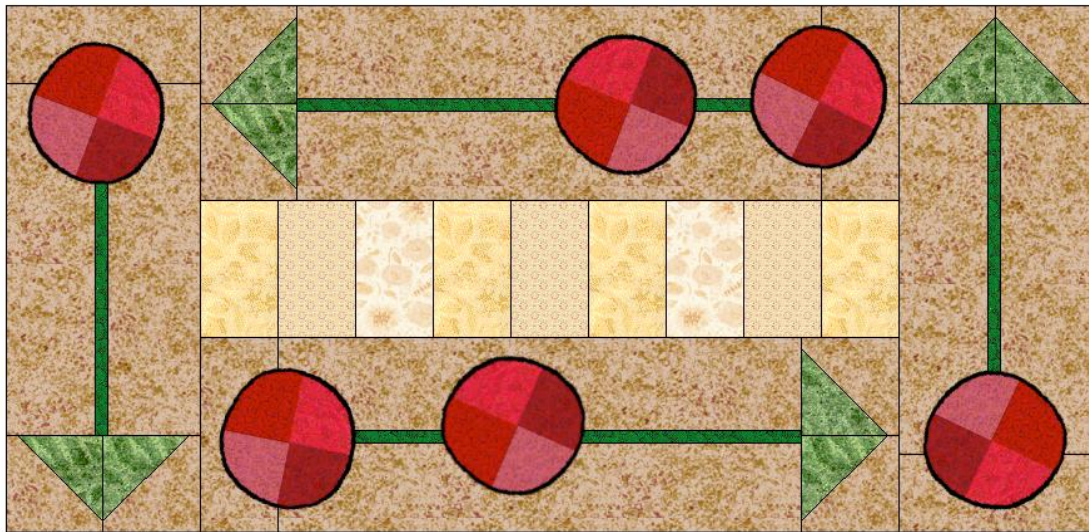
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## To the end

This is the part where you are going to sew "flowers". Here you get 3 different ways to do it, so read it all through before you start. Number 2 and 3 will be suitable for a wallhanging or has to be treated nice. Maybe you should quilt the table runner first?

Number 1 will be more for a table runner you would like to use a lot.



## Flowerchoice 1

1. Find **block A** : 6 four patches from the first part.
2. Fuse "Wonder Under" (or something similar) to the backside of each four patch.
3. Draw a circle on the paper side and cut on the line.
4. Place these "flowers" on the table runner where you want.
5. Sew them to the table runner, - by hand or machine.
6. Find some buttons and sew them in the middle of each "flower".  
Or cut out a small yellow circle from fabric and sew it onto the flower.

## Flowerchoice 2

1. Find **block A** : 6 four patches from the first part.
2. Cut 6 squares 4,5" from a matching fabric.
3. Place the fabric squares on top of the four patches, right sides together.
4. Draw a circle on the fabric square and sew around on the line.
5. Cut around the circle, cut a cross in the middle of the square ( at the back side) and turn the right side out.
6. Press the circle.
7. Place the "flowers" onto the table runner.

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8. Sew the "flowers" to the table runner, by hand or machine.
9. Find some nice buttons and sew them to each flower.

## Flowerchoice 3

1. Find **block A** : 6 four patches from the first part.
2. Cut 6 squares 4,5" from a matching fabric.
3. Place the fabric squares on top of the four patches, right sides together.
4. Sew the sides, but spare a small opening to turn the right sides out.
5. Turn the right side out.



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6. Sew the opening together at the same time as you stitch around the edges.
7. Place a coin at the middle and mark lightly around.
8. Use a strong thread in the needle and start at the backside by the marked circle.
9. Sew "basting" stitches to the side. Pull the thread to make creases ca. 1 ¼" long from the middle.
10. Sew back to the middle and secure the creases.
11. Do the same to each of the other three sides.
12. Place the "flowers" to the table runner with nice buttons.

## The end

1. Find the batting and the backside, quilt them together and sew the binding on.
2. Cut the binding :: 1 ½" x 88" (220 cm).

I do hope you had fun and got some ideas to make your own designs.
